POTLUCK GUIDELINES:

Time: 5:00pm – 7:00pm
Location: Kitchen Area, Fort Tejon, CA

Thank you for your interest in participating in the Saturday Evening Potluck! In order to ensure adequate quantities for all potluck participants, as well as due to the limitations of serving space, we are asking that potluck participants bring one item (or more) on the below Menu with a serving size for at least 6 people. **Please RSVP either individually or as a group/unit with your potluck item(s) choice to the Potluck Coordinator BEFORE the event. (Deadline: Tuesday, May 15, 2007).** Contact information is provided at the end of the page.

Please bring one of the following items to share:

- *Meat Dish (if you dislike pork, please feel free to bring your own meat dish)
- *Beans (such as barbeque or slow cooked)
- *Bread: Cornbread & or Wheat (or Regular) bread
- *Veggie (*any of the following*): Corn, Green Beans, or Carrots
- *Condiments & Misc. Items (*in addition to the above*): Butter, Honey, Salt, Pepper

In addition, if you so desire you may also bring a dessert item of your choice. Water and other beverages will be provided for you. If your food dish/item needs to be dropped off earlier in the day (i.e. – you are participating in the tactical), please make arrangements with the Potluck Coordinator BEFORE the event. There *may* be limited cooler space available for such items.

If an item needs to be cooked beforehand, and you do not have access to a fire-trench or firepit of your own, please contact the Organizers/Potluck Coordinator BEFORE the event to make arrangements for the use of one. (While we can assist in arranging a space to cook/heat your food for the potluck, please do not assume that we are able, or willing, to cook everyone's food for the potluck on-site. We are not a catering service.)

If a Unit is providing the food jointly, please provide to the Potluck Coordinator the following:

- List of food being provided on behalf of a Unit
- List of potluck attendees (names) in the said Unit
- Contact name of the designated person in the Unit who is bringing the food (& possibly dropping it off ahead of time)

Please be aware that each participant will need to provide his/her own set of dishes, cups/glassware, napkins, eating utensils, and any serving utensils required for your dishes. Hot soapy water will be provided at a designated clean up area. Please be kind and wash up after yourselves.

As a reminder, the Civilians may begin at 5:00pm, while the military expects to arrive at 6:00pm. While we expect the majority of the civilians to eat in the first shift, Civilians are welcome to eat with the military, if they so desire.
